<u>Sauti's trade and market information platforms</u> in Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda and Tanzania have been operating since 2017. This report shows user behaviour insights from Sauti's mobile information platform based on usage between 1 October to 31 December, 2021.



Key Insight

Since our Q2-Q3 2021 Report, trade within domestic markets has decreased in Tanzania by 5 percentage points to 81% while the country's cross-border trade has increased by 5 percentage points up to 19%


Total New Users Over Time
















Most Requested Product Categories


The categories below show the top 98 percent of commodity categories requested for each country. The remaining commodity categories with fewer requests are not shown on the graph.




Top Three Requested Products by Country




Requests for Commodity Prices in Cross-Border Markets[†]






Top Two Requested Markets for Commodity Prices in Each Platform[†]


